FOUNDATION




THE BLACK ACES



FIVE BANDS



GEORGE III

This 300-acre parcel first purchased by Beaulieu founder Georges de Latour in 1928 and called Beaulieu Vineyard Number 3, but in 1988, the vineyard has since been replanted using new Cabernet Sauvignon clones with tighter spacing and advanced trellising systems, enhancing both quality and grape tonnage.

ORCHARD AVENUE

A cooler area than other parts of the Napa Valley with soils that are rich clay, sloping down off of the foothills leading up to Mt. Veeder. The climate preserves acidity and brightness, and the soils yield tannin and structure.

CANDLESTICK RIDGE


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
